

Resolution No. 19513

WHEREAS, in the matter of the proposed opening, laying-out and establishing of Salmon Street, from the west line of 14th Street to the east line of Chapman Street, and also, Lownsdale Street, from the north line of the W.W. Chapman D.L.C. to the westerly extension of the north line of Salmon Street, in the City of Portland, Oregon, the full amount necessary to pay the damages allowed by the City Council and by appeals to the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Multnomah County has been paid into the City Treasury, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED, That Salmon Street, from the west line of 14th Street to the east line of Chapman Street, and also, Lownsdale Street, from the north line of the W.W. Chapman D.L.C. to the westerly extension of the north line of Salmon Street, in the City of Portland, Oregon, be and the same are hereby declared opened, laid out and established as city streets as provided by Ordinance No. 52062, adopting the report of the City Engineer, and Ordinance No. 56129, adopting the City Engineer's report made pursuant to Resolution No. 18697 making a deficit assessment for the extension of Salmon Street and Lownsdale Street; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City Engineer be and he is hereby instructed to record with the County Clerk of Multnomah County, Oregon, within ninety days after the adoption of this resolution a copy of this resolution and a map of said street extension.
