Resolution No. 20670

RESOLVED by the Council that it hereby requests the Governor of the State of Oregon to call a meeting in Portland, Oregon, of the Mayors of all of the cities in the State of Oregon directly using the waters of the Willamette River for sewage purposes and the Mayors of all of the cities in said state indirectly using the waters of the Willamette River for sewage purposes, in order that a workable plan may be agreed upon to establish sewage disposal plants in each of said cities that will obviate the necessity of the direct or indirect use of the waters of the Willamette River for sewage disposal, and the working out of a plan to borrow funds from the Reconstruction Finance Corporation to finance said project.
