
WHEREAS, all appeals that were taken to the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Multnomah County, from the award of damages made by Ordinance No. 63536 for the widening of Fourth Street Extension and laying out a new street, as particularly described in said ordinance, have been disposed of and judgments entered therein and certified copies of said judgments have been filed with the City Auditor, and the money for paying all damages allowed by said ordinance, as modified by the judgments on appeal, is in the hands of the City Treasurer ready for payment to all persons entitled thereto who have not heretofore received payment, and it has become the duty of the Auditor to draw warrants in favor of each and all persons so entitled who have not been heretofore paid, and thus all property required for said widening and new street in accordance with said ordinance, including certain slope rights and easements in addition to property actually taken, has been acquired, all of which are shown upon the map attached to the Engineer's report which was adopted by said ordinance; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Portland, Oregon, that said widening of said Fourth Street Extension and a new street as shown in said Engineer's report and Ordinance No. 63536, is hereby declared to have been opened, laid out and established together with said easements and other rights, and the City Engineer shall within ninety days from the date hereof file for record with the County Clerk of Multnomah County, Oregon, a copy of this resolution and an accurate plat of said streets showing the widened condition thereof, the property appropriated thereby and the sloping easements and other rights acquired in connection therewith; that the City Engineer on such map designate said street area by the official names heretofore adopted therefor, to wit, Southwest Barbur Boulevard and Southwest Bertha Boulevard, and it is hereby provided that this resolution shall supersede and include Resolution No. 20640 heretofore adopted for a portion of said street area, but neither this resolution nor the filing of said map marks a completion of the proceedings under the Portland charter amendment adopted November 8, 1932 concerning Fourth Street Extension, inasmuch as certain grade changes are to be made and certain small pieces of property not heretofore obtained are to be acquired.
