Whereas, Federal funds have now been allocated to the Oregon State Highway Commission in an amount exceeding \$6,000,000, and

Whereas, completion of this work at this time will furnish relief to many needy citizens of Portland, and at the same time complete a project that is important to the citizens of Portland; now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED, That the Council of the City of Portland request the Oregon State Highway Commission to complete the work program on the Lower Columbia River Highway from the Multnomah County line to Linnton, and that a copy of this resolution be forwarded to the Oregon State Highway Commission.
