

Resolution No. 20764

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WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Portland deems it expedient to open a new street, not less than 100 feet in width, such new street being a continuation of the super highway now being constructed from Oregon City to the southerly city limits, and to be laid out along the route tentatively approved by the State Highway Commission, the course of said route being from the southerly city boundary near SE 25th Avenue to a connection with SE 17th Avenue south of SE Schiller Street, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED that the City Engineer be and he is hereby directed to make a survey and plat of such proposed street and a written report thereon with authority to make such plat and report cover such alignment and width for said street as in his judgment may at this time be deemed advisable, and to include in said report an assessment of damages and an assessment of benefits to defray the costs of such proposed street, as provided by Section 522 of the Charter.
