

HARDSCAPE NOTE

In accordance with Planning code 33.510.242, the site must be landscaped within 6 months of the demolition of buildings unless there is an approved development for the site. Landscaping must meet at least the L1 standard of Chapter 33.248, Landscaping and Screening, except that



ALL MATERIALS SPILLED, DROPPED, WASHED, OR TRACKED FROM VEHICLES ONTO ROADWAYS OR INTO THE STORMWATER COLLECTION SYSTEMSHALL BE REMOVED OR CLEANED UP IMMEDIATELY, AND NO LATER THAN END OF THE WORKDAY. THE USE OF WATER TRUCKS TO WASH THE MATERIAL OFF THE ROADWAY IS NOT ALLOWED. WATER TRUCKS MAY BE USED IMMEDIATELY BEFORE SWEEPERS OF VACUUM SYSTEMS TO LOOSED SEDIMENT, PROVIDED THAT DISCHARGE TO THE STORMWATER COLLECTION SYSTEM DOES NOT OCCUR.

ADDITIONAL EROSION CONTROL MEASURES DETAILED IN THE CITY OF PORTLAND EROSION CONTROL MANUAL AND PCC TITLE 10 MAY BE REQUIRED BY CITY OF PORTLAND EROSION & SEDIMENT CONTROL INSPECTORS, THE CONTRACTOR, OR THE 24/7 EMERGENCY CONTACT DURING SITE WORK TO ENSURE MUD, SEDIMENT, OR SEDIMENT IMPACTED STORMWATER DOES NOT LEAVE THE PROJECT SITE.






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
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
