

To the Hon. Mayor & Common Council of the
City of Portland

The undersigned, would respectfully
call your attention to the fact, that, a large body of
water, coming down chiefly, from some one or more of
the ravines of what is known as Robinsons Hill,
in the South west part of the City, for some season,
is now, and has been for several weeks during
the present winter, forced to flow so that the
entire body enters Harrison Street at its int-
ersection with 3rd Street, thence following
Harrison to the bottom east of Front Street,
thereby causing great damage to property ~~located~~
on said street.

While it is expected that a fair share of water should
flow down said street, said Street ~~to~~ east of 3rd,
is now, from some cause, being made the channel
for the conveyance to the River of an amount of
water, which it is believed should be distributed
amongst perhaps a half dozen streets
