

Ordinance No. 31121

An Ordinance accepting certain property for street purposes.

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the following described property be and is hereby accepted by the City of Portland for street purposes:

First: Commencing at the southeast corner of Lot 1, Block 14, Simon's Addition to East Portland, now Portland; and running thence north along the east line of said Lot 1 a distance of 39 feet to a point; thence southwesterly on a curve to the right having a radius of 35.27 feet, a distance of 27.6 feet; thence on a reverse curve to the left having a radius of 140.85 feet to the south line of said Lot 1; thence east along the south line of said Lot 1, a distance of 22.5 feet to the place of beginning.

Second: Commencing at a point in the south line of Division Street, or Section Line Road, 927.66 feet west of the line between Sections 5 and 6, Township 1 South, Range 2, East, Willamette Meridian; running thence south 1389 feet; thence west 44 feet; thence north 1389 feet; thence east 44 feet to the place of beginning, being a strip of land 44 feet in width and extending from the south line of the Section Line Road or Division Street to the division line of the J. E. Witten Donation Land Claim.

Third: Commencing at the northwest corner of Lot 7, Block 6, Brush's Addition to East Portland, now Portland; and running thence south along the east line of East Twenty-fifth Street a distance of 38.4 feet; thence northeasterly on a curve to the right having a radius of 33.9 feet, a distance of 26.9 feet; thence on a reverse curve to the left having a radius of 141.4 feet to the north line of said Lot 7; thence west along the north line of said Lot 7 to the place of beginning.

Section 2. That the Auditor of the City of Portland be and is hereby directed to have the deeds to the property mentioned in Section 1 of this ordinance placed on record.
