SUBJECT: Portland Gay People's Alliance demonstration.

Details:

Information was received that the PORTLAND GAY PEOPLE'S ALLIANCE, Room 422 Smith Center Portland, State University, would conduct a demonstration on Saturday, June 23, 1973 from 10:00 A.M. to 12 noon on the Morrison St. side of the Pioneer Post Office. The purpose of this demonstration is to promote "gay pride".

On June 11, 1973 LESLIE MCKITTRICK, 118 N.W. King St. #51 applied for a sound permit to use a bull horn for this demonstration.

Other organizations which will possibly support this demonstration is the YOUNG SOCIALIST ALLIANCE and it is estimated that the participation will be in the neighborhood of 30 persons. There is no indication of any disorderly or violent acts within these demonstrators.

EXTRACT SECT. 16-1702 (1), ORDINANCE #76339: A PERMIT FOR SOUND AMPLIFYING DEVICE TO BE USED UPON THE STREETS OF THE CITY OF PORTLAND MAY BE GRANTED BY THE BUREAU OF POLICE UPON APPLICATION TO THE OFFICE OF THE CHIEF THEREOF, AND THE SAID BUREAU SHALL HAVE EXCLUSIVE JURISDICTION OVER THE ROUTING OF SUCH SOUND AMPLIFYING VEHICLE, AND SUCH VEHICLE SHALL IN NO EVENT BE PERMITTED TO OPERATE WITHIN TWO HUNDRED FEET OF ANY HOSPITAL, OR WITHIN TWO HUNDRED FEET OF ANY PUBLIC OR PRIVATE ELEMENTARY OR SECONDARY SCHOOL, OR ANY COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY. THE PERMIT AS GRANTED BY THE BUREAU OF POLICE SHALL IN ADDITION TO SPECIFYING THE ROUTE GENERALLY, OR SPECIFICALLY, AFFIRMATIVELY PROVIDE FOR THE HOURS DURING WHICH SUCH USE OF THE STREET MAY BE PERMITTED, AND SHALL PROVIDE THAT IN NO EVENT SHALL THE SOUND EMANATING FROM ANY SOUND AMPLIFYING VEHICLE BE AUDIBLE FOR A DISTANCE OF MORE THAN ONE HUNDRED FEET FROM THE SAID VEHICLE.
