Summary

Interstate 5 provides a critical connection between Oregon and Washington that supports local jobs and families, and is a vital trade route for regional, national, and international economies. However, bridge users are impacted by seismic issues, heavy congestion, safety issues, limited public transit options, and inadequate active transportation facilities. The IBR project will replace the bridge and make corridor improvements to a 5-mile stretch of I-5 in Oregon and Washington.

The IBR program will give a project update and discuss the upcoming Supplemental Environmental Impact Statement public comment period and how the commissions can participate.
