Injury Report:

All of these events occurred at or near the intersection of 12th and Jefferson, Portland Oregon on the 14th October. During 911 calls Portland Police officers made comments to the effect that children were being killed. This created a climate of such intensity that unsubstantiated claims led many officers to the area to assist in this fictitious crime. Officer Jonah bellman did run up behind me without any reason I was in no way a danger to anyone and without warning, or without first trying de-escalation techniques or the use of non-lethal methods or simply speaking to the claimant, he did attempt to shoot center mass and successfully shoot Jeremy James Rieck in the arm. Before this officer bellman did falsely radio in that Mr. Rieck had stabbed Aaron Stout via his radio. Once arrested officer John Oliphant did apply a tourniquet overly tight so as to stop almost completely the blood flow to Mr. Rieck's left arm. All of these actions have contributed to the temporary or permanent loss of function, range of motion, and strength in my arm. I am now grossly disfigured in a publicly viewable part of my body. I have endured extreme pain and emotional duress. The officers showed no regard for procedure or for the wellfair of Mr. Rieck. Is future treatment expected? Yes I expect a significant amount of surgery and physical therapy to repair and heal my injuries as well as for ongoing mental health issues related to the experience including "PTSD", anxiety, depression etc.
