Ordinance

Update salary grade for City Traffic Engineer classification

Passed

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. In accordance with the policies established by the City Council and based on a classification and compensation review, the Bureau of Human Resources is changing the salary grade of the City Traffic Engineer, effective 30 days after Council approval.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- A. The following compensation rates are changed, effective 30 days after Council approval:

Financial and Budgetary Impacts

There is no immediate fiscal impact. The annual maximum rate for the City Traffic Engineer classification is currently \$189,113.60. This ordinance will raise the annual maximum rate to \$220,958.40, an increase of \$31,844.80. The City Traffic Engineer is a single incumbent classification.

Community Impacts and Community Involvement

This action is largely internal to City government processes.

Budget Office Financial Impact Analysis

This action increases the maximum rate for the City Traffic Engineer by \$31,844. There is a single incumbent in this job class within the City. The salary grade change would have no immediate impact.
