17.92.030 Designation of Streets, Avenues, Boulevards and Drives.

- **A.** All streets within the corporate limits of the City running in an easterly and westerly direction shall hereafter be designated as with a "streets," street suffix and all streets running in a northerly and southerly direction shall be designated as with an "avenues." street suffix.
- **B.** Streets in Northeast, Northwest, Southeast, or Southwest Portland lying between two consecutively numbered north-south streets shall be designated as with a "place" street suffix and shall take the lesser number of said two numbered streets. underlying name of the street closest to the Willamette River,
- **C.** Streets in North Portland lying between two consecutively named north-south streets shall be designated with a "place" street suffix and shall take the underlying name of the street closest to Williams Avenue,
- **D.** Streets in South Portland lying between two consecutively named north-south streets shall be designated with a "place" street suffix and shall take the name of the underlying street closest to Naito Parkway or to View Point Terrace,
- **E.** Streets lying between two consecutively named east-west streets shall be designated with a "court" street suffix and shall take the underlying name of the street closest to Burnside Street.
- **<u>F.</u>** The terms street suffix "drive," "court," "lane," "terrace" or "way" may be used to designate winding or circuitous streets.
- **G.** Scenic, arterial or greenscape streets may be designated as with a "boulevards" street suffix or with a "drives" street suffix in lieu of the term a "streets" or "avenues." street suffix.
- **B.** H. All streets shall be designated by one name for the entire length.
