Outdoor Dining Program – Update

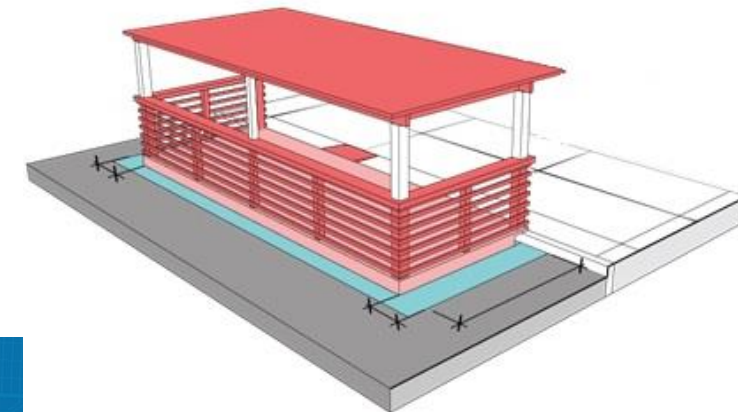
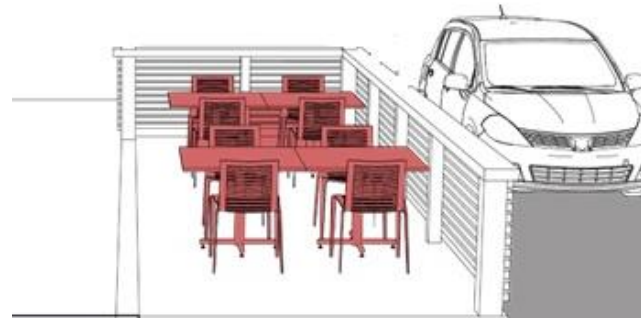
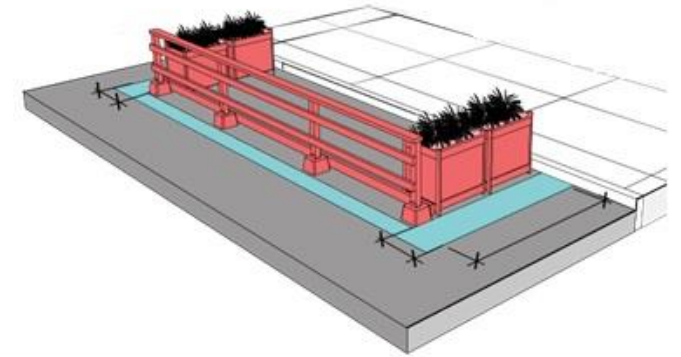
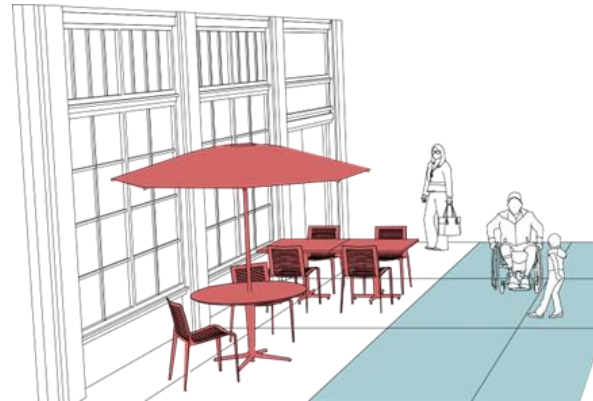
- On August 23rd - Outdoor Dining Program Report and Design Guidelines accepted by City Council which outlines key design guidelines, engagement efforts, permit participation and compliance strategies.
- **October 16th – New application window opens**
- Permit cycle begins January 1, 2024



Providing a range of permit types

Different businesses are willing to pay for different solutions:

- **Sidewalk Café:** sidewalk use only
- **Seasonal Street Seats:** light-weight street-level installations for six-month use
- **Street Seats with Platform:** no integrated roof structure
- **Street Seats with Platform and Roof:** More robust installations with overhead structures



Fees and Code Changes

As part of program implementation, PBOT needs to update relevant admin rules and request certain code exceptions:

- **TRN 10.04 - Sidewalk Café Permit & PCC 17.25 Sidewalk Cafes** to reflect program changes
- **City Code 17.60 Underground Wiring Districts** to allow for ornamental lighting over outdoor dining installations, as well as to provide power for electric heaters
- **Exhibit C - Fees, Rates and Charges for Transportation Development & Street Systems Management Services, of TRN-3.450**
