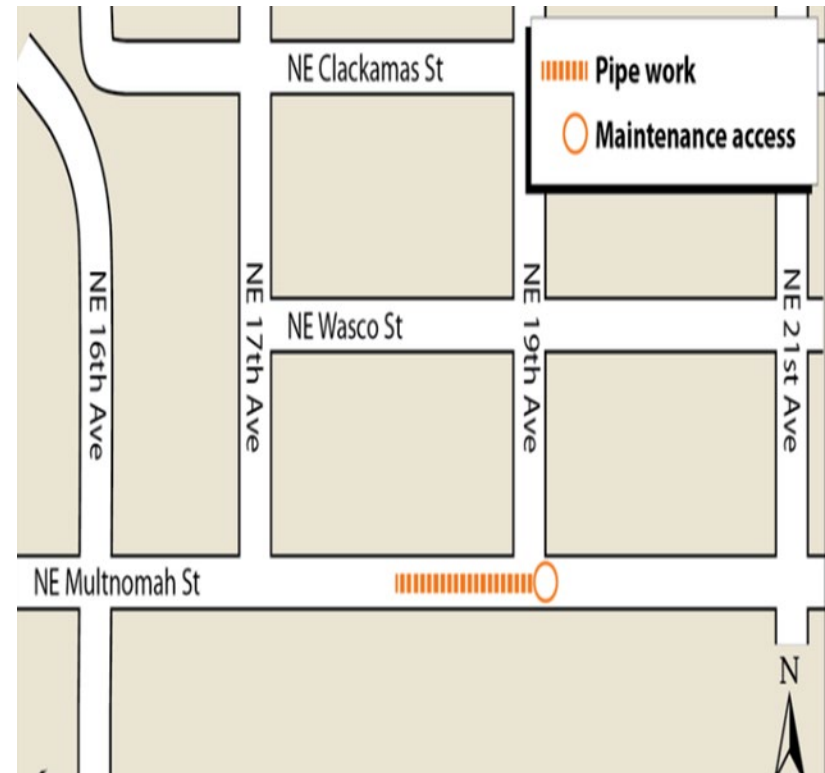

Project Overview

NE Portland Urgent Sewer Rehabilitation

- Two project areas combined into one project number
- Sullivan's Gulch Neighborhood (NE Multnomah St. from NE 17th Ave to NE 19th Ave.)
- 238' of upsized pipe (12" to 21") open cut construction.
- Two inlets, four service laterals, one new MH

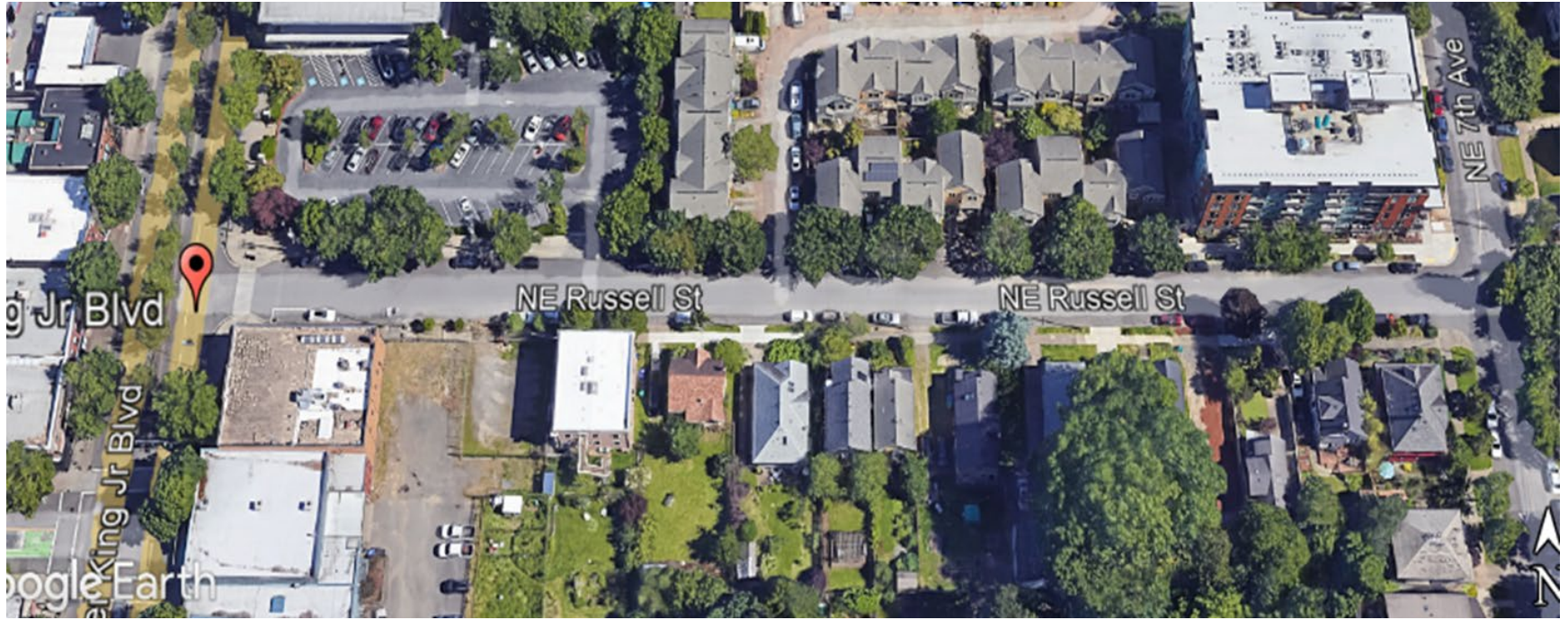




Project Overview

- Second project area.
- Irvington Neighborhood (NE MLK Jr. Blvd. to NE 7th Ave.)
- 739' of upsized pipe (10" to 12") open cut construction.
- Two inlets, twenty-six service laterals, three new MH.
