

ORDINANCE No. 135882

An Ordinance authorizing the Purchasing Agent to advertise and receive proposals for furnishing all materials, equipment and labor and for restoring Captain John Brown House for the Department of Public Works, authorizing a contract therefor, authorizing the drawing and delivery of warrants, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Purchasing Agent hereby is authorized and directed to advertise and receive proposals for furnishing all materials, equipment and labor and for restoring Captain John Brown House for the Department of Public Works, in accordance with the plans and specifications therefor filed in the Bureau of Purchases January 12, 1973, which plans and specifications hereby are adopted and by this reference made a part of this ordinance.

Section 2. The Mayor and the Commissioner of Public Works hereby are authorized to enter into a contract with the responsible bidder submitting the most advantageous bid for the project mentioned in Section 1 hereof. The Council hereby reserves the right to reject any and/or all bids, in whole or in part, and, in the event that no satisfactory bid is received, the Purchasing Agent hereby is authorized to readvertise therefor on the same basic plans and specifications until a satisfactory bid is received. The Mayor and the Auditor hereby are authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the Capital Improvements Fund, Appropriation John Brown House Project, Improvements (6702.760), when demand is presented, approved by the proper authorities.

Section 3. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Portland in this: in order that there may be no delay in providing authority for the contract for the project described in Section 1 hereof, this ordinance should be effective immediately upon its passage; therefore, an emergency hereby is declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
