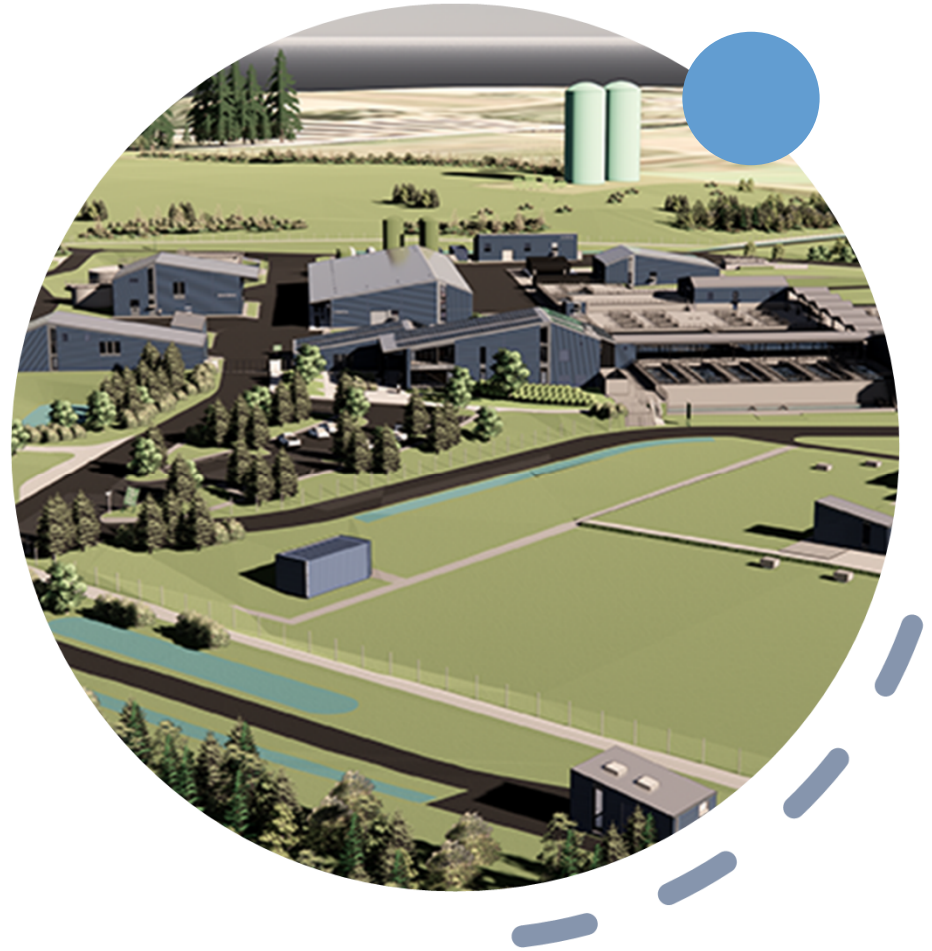
Council Action: Arborist services emergency procurement

Authorize an emergency contract with Forest Restoration, Inc., dba Integrated Resource Management for an estimated amount of \$244,422.82 for arborist services. (Ordinance)



Overview

- Filtration projects are located and designed to reduce impacts, including tree impacts
 - Facility site previously deforested/farmed
 - Pipelines primarily located within ROW
- Some tree/brush removal is required where:
 - Necessary for road improvements (widening) from Land Use Conditions of Approval
 - Physically impacted by construction
- All work must comply with WIFIA requirements



Why Emergency Contract

- Early work on project requires some tree removal for road improvements and grading
- Concerns regarding Migratory Bird Nesting season
- Doing removal now mitigates potentially significant delays to project construction
- Existing city contract did not meet WIFIA requirements, thus driving Emergency Ordinance
- Permitted work was successfully completed prior to nesting season

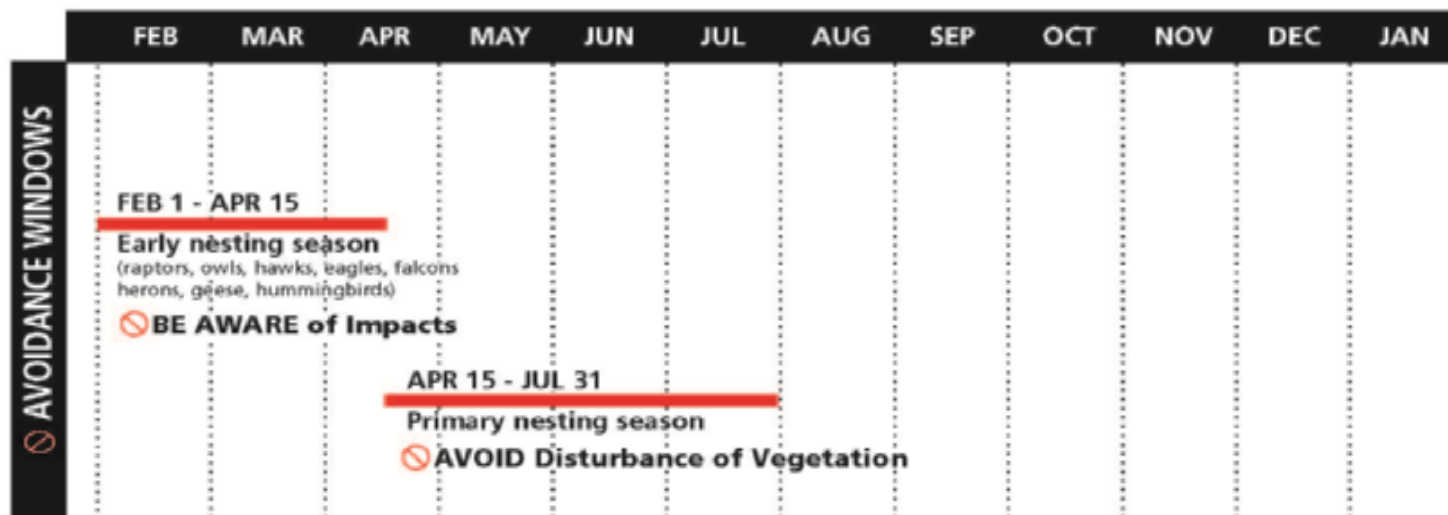

<p>GENERAL APPLICATION/PERMIT TERMS:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Applicant shall become the "Permittee." 2. Permittee must notify Multnomah County of 503-988-3882, at least one business day (24 hours) before commencing work under this permit. 3. Except as allowed under the Multnomah County Road Rules Section 18, Subsection 18.205, Permittee must complete any authorized demolition, installation, construction, placement, or similar work activities in the road right-of-way not later than 120 days after Permit Effective Date. Any extension of time beyond that period is subject to the sole discretion of Multnomah County. 4. Any permit issued pursuant to this application shall be applicable only to the specific public road right-of-way under the jurisdiction of Multnomah County authorized and identified herein. Applicant must obtain an additional permit or consent from Multnomah County for the use of any other public road right-of-way under the County's jurisdiction. 5. Applicant must obtain the consent from the appropriate authority for the use of any roads, highways, and streets that are not under Multnomah County's jurisdiction. 6. This Permit shall not be effective until a construction plan, specifications or other similar documentation has been reviewed and approved by the County Engineer or designee and incorporated into the Permit. 7. This Permit includes the "Permit Provisions" attached hereto and which are incorporated by this reference. Authority: ORS 316.300-320; 316.330; MCC Chapters 21 and 201.

Tree Permit

Migratory Bird Nesting Season Act

- Protects native bird species
 - “No person may take (kill), possess, import, export, transport, sell, purchase, barter, or offer for sale, any migratory bird, or the parts, nests, or eggs of such bird except as may be permitted under the terms of a valid permit...” – U.S. Fish & Wildlife Service

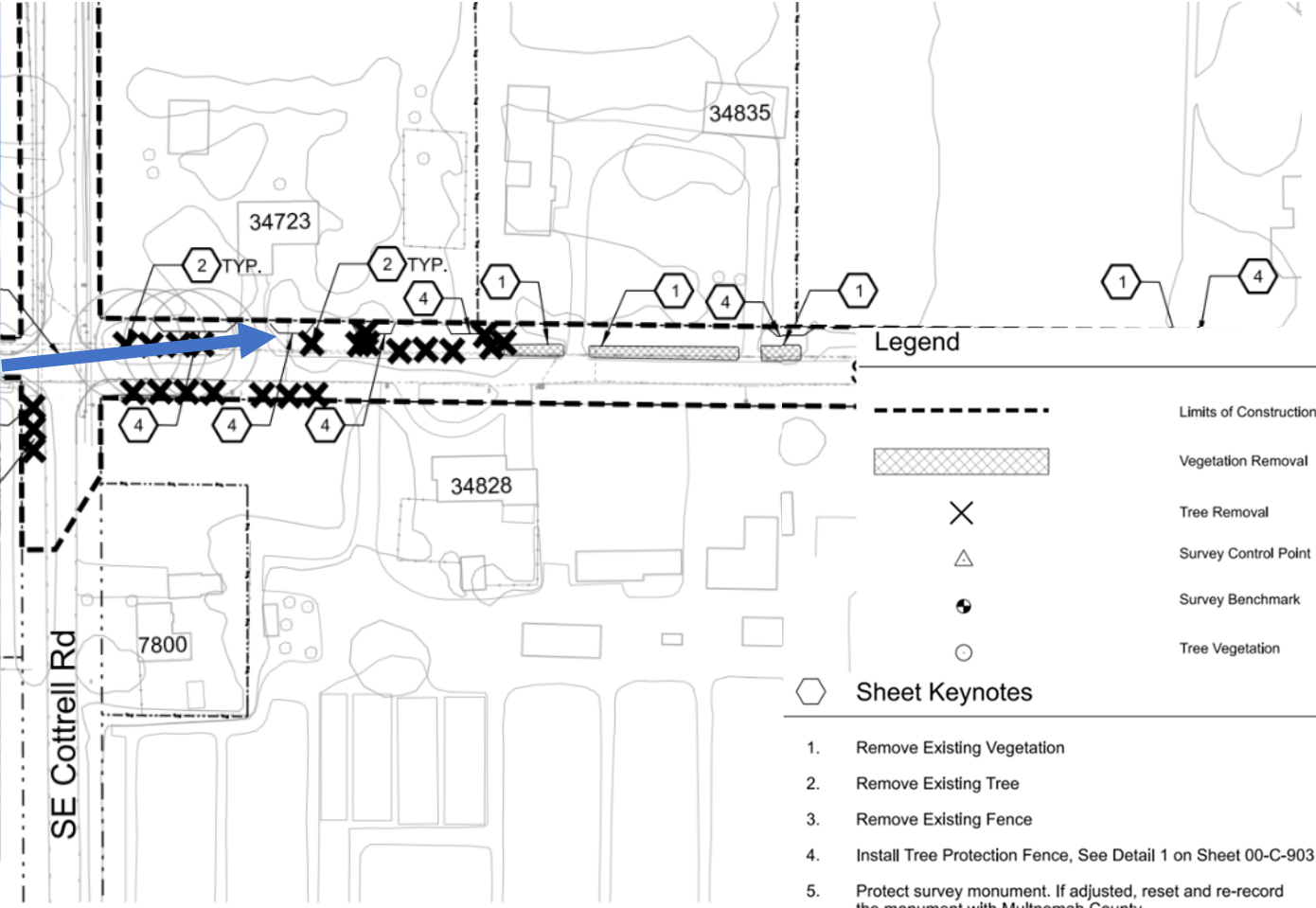
Bird Nesting Season and Work Windows
