

ORDINANCE NO. 134875

An Ordinance authorizing the Purchasing Agent to advertise and receive proposals for furnishing mercury vapor luminaires and mast arms for the Bureau of Lighting, authorizing the Bureau of Lighting, and delivering a contract therefor, authorizing the drawing and delivery of warrants, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Purchasing Agent hereby is authorized and directed to advertise and receive proposals for furnishing mercury vapor luminaires and mast arms for the Bureau of Lighting, Utility Rates and Use, Department of Public Utilities, in accordance with the specifications therefor filed in the Bureau of Purchases June 29, 1972, which specifications hereby are adopted and by this reference made a part of this ordinance as filed in the Bureau of Purchases.

Section 2. The Commissioner of Public Utilities and the Mayor hereby are authorized to enter into a contract with the responsible bidder submitting the most advantageous bid for the items mentioned in Section 1 hereof. The Council hereby reserves the right to reject any and/or all bids, in whole or in part, and in the event that no satisfactory bid is received, the Purchasing Agent hereby is authorized to readvertise therefor until a satisfactory bid is received, provided that there are no changes in the specifications hereinabove by reference made a part of this ordinance. The Mayor and the Auditor hereby are authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the Street Lighting Fund, Street Lighting Installation (5645.288), when demand is presented, approved by the proper authorities.

Section 3. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Portland in this: in order that there may be no delay in providing authority for the contract for the project mentioned in Section 1 hereof, this ordinance should be effective immediately upon its passage; therefore, an emergency hereby is declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
