Outreach

IPR Senior Community Outreach Coordinator Irene Konev is reaching out to organizations, community leaders and individuals for the Citizen Review Committee (CRC) recruitment. She networked at Say Hey Northwest, Black Women Taking Charge Networking event, met with IRCO staff, Race Talks staff and individuals interested in serving on the CRC.
