Independent Police Review (IPR) Work Plan / Accomplishments

IPR Operations

IPR has moved out of the Auditor's Office and is being set up as an independent office within the City. We have kept the same office space and are working through details of that transition. We will begin filling vacant positions as soon as possible. IPR staff is currently working a hybrid schedule similar to many other City of Portland employees. We continue to take complaints online, by phone or by mail and now have some walk-in options.

Deputy Director Dana Walton-Macaulay left for another position July 1 and Kelsey Lloyd was recently promoted into the Deputy Director position. Kelsey has been with IPR for over 10 years.

Settlement Agreement

There was a status check in front of Judge Simon on July 27th and another will take place in October. CRC will receive an update on the Settlement Agreement from the City Attorney's Office at the September meeting.
