#### Independent Police Review (IPR) Work Plan / Accomplishments

#### **IPR Operations**

<u>Body Worn Cameras</u>: The pilot continues with PPB members at Central Precinct and the Focus Intervention Team wearing cameras. IPR has multiple investigations underway that involve body worn cameras and we are working through access issues with PPB Records Division.
