or Workgroup consensus participation requires attendance at two (2) meetings and a commitment to future regular attendance."

Please correct any record to reflect that EPAP Housing Subcommittee, NOT the general EPAP authorized this statement. Yesika Arévalo has been apprised of this request for adjustment and agrees that the record should be corrected to identify her testimony as attributable to consensus of the EPAP Housing Subcommittee.
