**Re:** Request for Testimony Correction: East Portland Action Plan (EPAP) Housing Subcommittee, NOT the full EPAP, authorized Yesika Arévalo's testimony at the Portland Planning and Sustainability Commission on June 12, 2018 related to Better Housing By Design.

Dear Mayor; Commissioners Eudaly, Fish, Fritz, and Saltzman; Planning & Sustainability Commission; Portland Bureau of Planning and Sustainability Director Anderson; and Better Housing by Design Committee Manager, Bill Cunningham:

EPAP Housing Subcommittee authorized the June 12, 2018 testimony related to Better Housing By Design presented by Yesika Arévalo to the Portland Planning and Sustainability Commission. This testimony was NOT authorized by consensus at a general EPAP meeting, so the testimony was representative of the Housing Subcommittee, not the entire EPAP, based upon our "Structures" document:

#### **"DECISION-MAKING**

The EPAP will craft and recommend approaches and solutions that are workable for a wide range of needs and interests, based upon the 'Guiding Principles' identified above. The EPAP operates using a consensus model. Committees and Subcommittees can make public statements that are specific to their group. Proposals seeking approval from the general EPAP will be decided by Participating Agreement (PA) signing members. Committee, Subcommittee,

or Workgroup consensus participation requires attendance at two (2) meetings and a commitment to future regular attendance.”

Please correct any record to reflect that EPAP Housing Subcommittee, NOT the general EPAP authorized this statement. Yesika Arévalo has been apprised of this request for adjustment and agrees that the record should be corrected to identify her testimony as attributable to consensus of the EPAP Housing Subcommittee.
