ORDINANCE No. 112431

An Ordinance authorizing the drawing and delivery of a warrant in the amount of \$37.50, payable to The Bee Company, in settlement of a claim for property damage, providing for release and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1. The Council finds that The Bee Company, 1005 N. Failing Street, Portland, Oregon, has heretofore filed a claim against the City for damage to property allegedly caused by break in water line on or about July 11, 1960; that said claim has been considered by the Committee on Claims, which committee by report to Council on August 4, 1960, Council Calendar No. 3021 (1960), recommended settlement of the claim in the amount of \$37.50; now, therefore, the Mayor and Auditor hereby are authorized and directed to draw and deliver a warrant in the amount of \$37.50, payable to The Bee Company, said warrant to be drawn against and charged to Water Fund (5700.650).

Section 2. Delivery of the warrant authorized in Section 1 hereof shall be conditioned upon the execution and filing with the Auditor of a release signed by Herbert D. Hochfeld, an individual doing business as The Bee Company, such release to be in form approved by the City Attorney, and to be in full and complete satisfaction of any and all claims against the City of Portland, its officers, agents and employes arising out of or in connection with the claim mentioned in Section 1 hereof.
