SUMMARY OF REMONSTRANCES AND FINDINGS TO COUNCIL

Amend the NW Park Ave and Johnson-Kearney St Local Improvement District to construct only NW Johnson St and NW Kearney St and to construct NW Park Ave in a separate and newly-formed NW Park Ave Local Improvement District in conjunction with the segregation of pending local improvement district liens (Hearing; C-10069)

No written remonstrance representing any of the owners of the 17 nonexempt properties in the NW Park Ave and Johnson-Kearney St Local Improvement District Improvement District was received by the filing deadline registering objections to formation of the local improvement district.

It is the recommendation of the Local Improvement District Administrator that the City Council overrule any and all objections and approve the major scope change to the NW Park Ave and Johnson-Kearney St Local Improvement District.
