

ORDINANCE NO. 6059.

An Ordinance adopting the report of the City Surveyor in the matter of the proposed northerly extension of North Twenty Fourth street in Goldsmith's Addition to the City of Portland from the north line of "T" street northerly in its present course and width to the center line of St Helens County Road

The City of Portland does ordain as follows;

Section 1;- That whereas the Common Council of the City of Portland deeming it expedient to mark the boundaries of a proposed northerly extension of North Twenty Fourth street in Goldsmith's Addition to the City of Portland from the north line of "T" street northerly in its present course and width to the center line of the St Helens County Road did on the 20th day of November 1889 direct the City Surveyor to survey the same ^{and} make his report of such survey containing a plat thereof and a full and perfect description of such proposed street extension and the boundaries thereof and of the portion of each tract or lot or part thereof to be appropriated to public use for such proposed street extension and the City Surveyor having made such survey, report and plat and filed the same in the office of the Auditor and Clerk and the same being satisfactory to the Common Council therefore the said report of E.W. Paget City Surveyor in the matter of the proposed northerly extension of North Twenty Fourth street in Goldsmith's Addition to the City of Portland from the north line of "T" street northerly in its present course and width to the center line of the St Helens County Road is hereby adopted, and of which said report

To the Hon. the Common Council of the City of Portland.

Gentlemen:-

In pursuance of a resolution adopted by your Hon. Body at your regular meeting of Wednesday evening November 20th A.D. 1889, directing me to survey and mark the boundaries of a northerly extension of North Twenty Fourth Street in Goldsmith's Addition to the City of Portland, from the north line of "T" street, northerly in its present course and width to the center line of the St Helen's County Road, I have surveyed and marked the boundaries of such proposed extension and herein submit my report containing a plat of said survey.

The proposed extension of North Twenty Fourth street is sixty (60) feet in width and is more particularly bounded and described as follows; to wit;

Beginning at a point on the west line of North Twenty Fourth street where the same is intersected by the north line of "T" street in Balch's Addition to the City of Portland, run thence northerly on a northerly extension in its present course of the westerly side line of North Twenty Fourth street in Goldsmith's Addition to the City of Portland, to the center line of the St Helen's County Road; thence easterly in a straight line along the center line of the St Helen's County Road sixty (60) feet or more to a point in a northerly extension in its present course of the easterly side line of North Twenty Fourth

street in Goldsmith's Addition to the City of Portland, thence southerly along said northerly extension of the east line of North Twenty Fourth street, to the north line of "T" street in Balch's Addition to the City of Portland; thence westerly along the north line of "T" street sixty (60) feet to the place of beginning.

The proposed extension of North Twenty Fourth street will include and necessitate the appropriation to public use of the following described parcels or tracts of land, to wit;

All that part of Lot No. 2 in Block No. 323 in Balch's Addition to the City of Portland which lies west of the west line of the proposed extension of North Twenty Fourth street owned by P. L. Willis and containing thirteen hundred and five (1305) square feet; also

All that part of Lot No. 3 in Block No. 323 in Balch's Addition to the City of Portland which lies east of the west line of the proposed extension of North Twenty Fourth street owned by P. L. Willis and containing twelve hundred and sixty nine (1269) square feet, also;

All that part of Lot No. 2 in Block No. 6 in Wilson's Addition to the City of Portland which lies west of the east line of the proposed extension of North Twenty Fourth street, owned by Geo. Good and containing six hundred and seven (607) square feet also

All that part of Lot No. 3 in Block No. 6 in Wilson's Addition to the City of Portland which lies west of the east line of the proposed extension of North Twenty Fourth street owned by W. M. Ladd and containing four hundred and seventy two (472)

square feet;also

All that part of Lot No.6 in Block No.6 in Wilson's Addition to the City of Portland which lies west of the east line of the proposed extension of North Twenty Fourth street owned by W.M.Ladd and containing three hundred and thirty seven (337) square feet;also

All that part of Lot No.7 in Block No.6 in Wilson's Addition to the City of Portland which lies west of the east line of the proposed extension of North Twenty Fourth street owned by T.E.and F.Richet in undivided one half interests and containing two hundred and two (202) square feet;also

All that part of Lot No.10 in Block No.6 in Wilson's Addition to the City of Portland which lies west of the east line of the proposed extension of North Twenty Fourth street owned by J.K.Wilson and containing sixty seven (67) square feet;also

All that part of Lot No.12 in Block No.7 in Wilson's Addition to the City of Portland which lies east of the west line of the proposed extension of North Twenty Fourth street owned by T.E.and F.Richet in undivided one half interests and containing sixty four (64) square feet;also

All that part of Lot No.13 in Block No.7 in Wilson's Addition to the City of Portland which lies east of the west line of the proposed extension of North Twenty Fourth street owned by T.E.and F.Richet in undivided one half interests and containing one hundred and ninety six (196) square feet;also

All that part of lot No.16 in Block No.7 in Wilson's Addition to the City of Portland which lies east of the west line of the proposed extension of North Twenty Fourth Street

owned by Annie Campbell and containing three hundred and thirty (330) square feet;also

All that part of Lot No.17 in Block No.7 in Wilson's Addition to the City of Portland which lies east of the west line of the proposed extension of North Twenty Fourth street owned by Annie Campbell and containing four hundred and fifteen (415) square feet;also

All that parcel or tract of land which lies between the east and west lines of the proposed extension of North Twenty Fourth street and between the north line of Wilson's Addition to the City of Portland and the division line between the north and south halves of the W.Blackistone Donation Land Claim containing twenty one thousand seven hundred and eighty (21,780) square feet;thecaforsaid tract of land being owned in undivided interests as follows;D.P.Thompson one quarter interest,Ellis G. Hughes one quarter interest,Jacob Meyer one eighth interest,L.Fleischner one eighth interest,S.Hirsch one eighth interest and T.A.Javis one eighth interest;also

All that parcel or tract of land which lies between the east and west lines of the proposed extension of North Twenty Fourth street and between the division line between the north and south halves of the W.Blackistone Donation Land Claim and the south line of a tract of land owned by Nicholas Versteeg owned by W.S.Ladd and containing thirty eight thousand two hundred and eighty (38280) square feet;also

All that parcel or tract of land lying between the east and west lines of the proposed extension of North Twenty Fourth street and between the south line of a tract of land owned by Nicholas Versteeg and the center line of the St Helen's County

Road owned by Nicholas Versteeg and containing nineteen thousand
two hundred (19,200) square feet.
