Candidates: Any resident of Model Neighborhood 18 years of age or above may file for candidacy - filing deadline is Monday, September 22, 1969.

Just prior to the final day for filing for positions on the CPB a question was raised concerning the results of the March 2, 1968 election.

An investigation revealed that the count made by The League of Women Voters was certified, and was the same as that reported to the board by Tom Brumm a month ago.

It is evident that the ballot box was opened at least once a short time after the election and that it has remained open for the past month. This means that a valid recount at this late date is impossible.

It is the decision of the executive ~~board~~^{committee} that the count made by The League of Women Voters shall stand.

Dear Sir:

Permit us to bring to your attention a matter which we feel is most urgent and requires immediate attention of yourself, as well as, other Model Cities Board Members. We are sure you are aware that prior to the recent Model Cities election, which was held September 9, 1969, an inquiry was made to the Model Cities Office as to the actual count of the Highland-King School District results from the past election of 1968.

Information was received from the Model Cities Director, Mr. Alvin Batiste to the effect that the winner of the 1968 election of the Highland-King School District was Mr. Otto Rutherford first place with a total of 71 votes and Mr. E.J. Baskett second place with a total of 70 votes.

WE have been advised that you as Chairman of the Model Cities Board, were amply informed of these statistics, based upon the rules voted by the Model Cities Board, for eligible candidates to remain on the board without filing for re-election. Obviously, Mr. E.J. Baskett has not met the criteria for remaining on the board for one year without filing for re-election, in accordance with the stipulated board regulations. You were properly informed of the above data and had sufficient time to inform all board members and particularly, Mr. E.J. Baskett of the need to file on or before the September 23, 1969 deadline. Since he did not meet this deadline, evidently wishing to ignore this information and failing to meet these requirements, it is your duty to inform him and the board members that he is no longer a member of the present Model Cities Board.

As chairman of the board, we are sure you recognize the importance of your responsibility to uphold the rules and act in the best interest of the people of the Model Cities area.

We would like to feel that you will act to rectify this gross injustice, without the necessity of us resorting to legal action, in order to give the people of the Highland-King School District their proper representative.
