Gentlemen:

Your Committee

on Health & Police

to whom was

referred the annexed Petition of the Portland Water Company for the removal of the Pest House from their lands. We respectfully report that they have given the subject matter thereof due consideration and respectfully recommend to your Hon. Body that the Pest House be removed from said Portland Water Company lands, or that the same be abandoned, the City having no right to maintain the same on the lands of said Company without their consent. Your Committee has selected a site for a Pest House upon the Poor Farm with the assent and assistance of the County Court & Commissioners, with the understanding that authority will be granted to the City to use a tract sufficiently large for that purpose. The place selected is upon a southern slope, well drained sunny and healthfully located, and we recommend that a suitable building be erected thereon.
