

Ordinance No. 20165

An Ordinance declaring the cost of improving Thurman Street, from the east line of Twenty-fifth Street to the east end of the steel bridge on Thurman Street, said point being 220 feet westerly from the west line of Twenty-ninth Street, and assessing the property benefited thereby, declaring such assessment and directing the entry of the same in the Docket of City Liens.

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. That the Council has considered the proposed assessment for improving Thurman Street from the east line of Twenty-fifth Street to the east end of the steel bridge on Thurman Street, said point being 220 feet westerly from the west line of Twenty-ninth Street,

and all objections made thereto, and hereby ascertains, determines and declares the whole cost of said improvement in the manner provided by Ordinance No. 18923 to be the sum of \$ 30,427.48 and that the special and peculiar benefits accruing to each lot or part thereof or parcel of land within the assessment district, by reason of said improvement and in just proportion to such benefits, are in the respective amounts set opposite the number or description of each lot or part thereof or parcel of land in the annexed assessment roll, and said assessment roll, which is numbered 892 is hereby adopted and approved as the assessment for said improvement, and the Auditor of the City of Portland is directed to enter a statement of the assessment hereby made in the Docket of City Liens, and cause notice thereof to be published as provided by Charter.
