Gentlemen:

The City Planning, at its February 17, 1970 meeting, voted to recommend approval of the Second Amendment to the Urban Renewal Plan for the Portland State University project as proposed by the Portland Development Commission.

This proposed amendment provides for minor land acquisition revisions in the plan.

1. A small parcel at the S. W. corner of S. W. 12th and Montgomery is not to be acquired from the State Highway Commission since its use is for landscaping by the Highway Commission. This seems reasonable since the orientation is primarily to the Stadium Freeway.
2. A small parcel on the S. W. corner of Block 232 is proposed to be sold to the owner of the Park Plaza. This arrangement appears satisfactory to all parties.
