

# ORDINANCE No. 136058

An Ordinance creating two temporary postions for 8 months in Model Cities for the Resident Employment and Training Plan, fixing the rates of pay, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:


Section 1. The Council finds that a Resident Employment and Training Plan is being implemented by Model Cities to enlarge the employment, training and career opportunities for the residents of the Portland Model Neighborhood, employees of Model Cities and employees of contracting agencies; that a Personnel and Training Supervisor and a Stenographer Clerk are required for 8 months to provide the necessary staff; and that the two positions should be created; now, therefore, the following temporary positions are hereby created in the Model Cities Fund, Citizen Participation Division (6682.112) for a period of eight months with salaries as indicated:

Personnel & Training Supervisor	\$5.87 per hour flat rate
Stenographer Clerk	Per City Compensation Plan


Section 2. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Portland in this: In order that the Resident Employment and Training Plan may be implemented without undue delay; therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
