Regular meetings, work sessions, and executive sessions = 7 Councilors


Committee meetings = a majority of committee members



### **Additional Types of Council Meetings**

#### **Work sessions**

Quorum is a majority of committee members

Quorum = 7 Councilors

Quorum = 7 Councilors



### **Public Meetings**

- Open to the public with electronic option for attendance (hybrid meetings)
- Notice of time and place of meetings, including subject(s) to be considered (agenda)
- Meetings are accessible
- Notice must be posted at least 24 hours before each meeting
- Minutes



"The Oregon form of government requires an informed public aware of the deliberations and decisions of governing bodies and the information upon which such decisions were made. It is the intent of [the Public Meetings Law] that decisions of governing bodies be arrived at openly."

Councilor – Councilor's Senior Aide

**Committee** – Chair or Vice Chair of the committee, Senior Aides for Chair or Vice Chair, Council Policy Analyst

**Mayor** – Mayor's Senior Aide, City Administrator, Deputy City Administrator, Assistant City Administrator

Auditor – Chief Deputy City Auditor, Auditor's General Counsel, Audit Services Director

An elected official or committee may designate another position to file agenda documents by submitting a written designation to the Council Clerk.

### What Happens at a Regular Council Meeting




- Presiding Officer

- No formal agenda
- Staff or invited speakers present information
- Council discussion
- Public testimony is not heard





### What Will Happen at the First Meeting on January 2

- The President and Vice President will be elected.
  - The Council Clerk and assisted by legal counsel, will serve as a non-voting ex officion
     presiding officer to facilitate the election of the first President.
- Public communications (5) will be heard.


