ORDINANCE No. 134390

An Ordinance authorizing and directing Charles Jordan, Director of Model Cities, to discuss Model Cities programs in San Diego, Oakland, Richmond, and San Jose, California, April 24-26, 1972, authorizing a warrant for \$272, providing for an accounting, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds that the Model Cities of San Diego, Oakland, Richmond and San Jose are in the process of going through or completed new organizational structures; that the Commissioner in charge of the Model Cities Program has recommended sending Charles Jordan, Director, to these cities to evaluate their programs; and that it would be in the best interest of the City of Portland to provide for his travel; now, therefore, Charles Jordan is hereby authorized and directed to discuss Model Cities programs in San Diego, Oakland, Richmond, and San Jose, California, April 24-26, 1972. The Mayor and the Auditor are hereby authorized to draw a warrant for \$272 in favor of Charles Jordan as an advance for expenses. Said warrant shall be charged to the Model Cities Fund appropriation Model Cities Administration, Travel and Transportation (6681.310). Charles Jordan shall file with the Auditor an accounting of actual expenses together with available receipts, and any remaining balance shall be deposited with the Treasurer and credited to the above appropriation.

Section 2. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Portland in this: In order that Charles Jordan may make arrangements without delay to travel to California, April 24-26, 1972; therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
