

## ORDINANCE NO. 132365

An Ordinance creating one temporary position of Employment Specialist and two temporary positions of Administrative Intern in the Office of the Mayor from March 18, 1971, through June 15, 1971, to prepare a Model Cities resident employment plan, establishing the rates of pay, limiting the services to \$4,000, providing for reimbursement from the Model Cities Fund, transferring \$4,000 from Reimbursable Expenditures, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds that a Model Cities resident employment and training plan is required by the Department of Housing and Urban Development; that the cost of preparing the plan will be paid by the Model Cities Fund; that the plan is to be developed under the direction of the City Manpower Coordinator; that work on the plan is to be started March 18, 1971, and completed by June 15, 1971; that it is necessary to create one temporary position of Employment Specialist and two temporary positions of Administrative Intern for the research, analysis, and writing necessary to formulate the plan; that these positions should be created in the Office of the Mayor as a manpower unit in order to separate the accounting for these expenditures from the accounting for the manpower grant which is administered by the Manpower Coordinator; that the cost of these three positions is to be reimbursed by the Model Cities Fund; that the total for salaries, payroll taxes, and any other expenses is to be limited to \$4,000; and that \$4,000 should be transferred from Reimbursable Expenditures to the Office of the Mayor; now, therefore, one temporary position of Employment Specialist and two temporary positions of Administrative Intern are hereby created in the Office of the Mayor from March 18, 1971, through June 15, 1971, for the preparation of a Model Cities resident employment and training plan. The salary for the position of Employment Specialist shall be \$381.60 bi-weekly and the salary for the positions of Administrative Intern shall be within the range from \$2.50 per hour to \$3.00 per hour depending upon qualifications of the persons employed. Total expenditures for salaries, payroll taxes, and any operation and maintenance expenditures charged to the Mayor's office are hereby limited to \$4,000, and 100% of actual expenditures shall be reimbursed from the Model Cities Fund.


Section 2. The sum of \$4,000 is hereby transferred within the General Fund from the appropriation Reimbursable Expenditures (5191) to the appropriation Office of the Mayor, Personal Services (100.110).

Section 3. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Portland in this: In order that the positions created in Section 1 of this ordinance may be authorized without undue delay; therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.


