An Ordinance ratifying the action of the Commissioner of Finance and Administration in sending the Deputy Director of Model Cities, J. Alton Page, to San Francisco, California, January 27-30, 1970 to attend the Conference on Economic Development and Manpower; authorizing a warrant for \$261.30; providing for an accounting; and declaring an emergency.


The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds that the Department of Housing and Urban Development regional office in San Francisco, California, conducted a Conference on Economic Development and Manpower January 27-30, 1970; that the Acting Director of Model Cities, Kenneth Hampton, recommended to the Commissioner of Finance and Administration that J. Alton Page, Deputy Director, attend this conference; that the Commissioner of Finance and Administration directed J. Alton Page to attend the conference; and that this action should be ratified and funds for expenses incurred should be provided; now, therefore, the action of the Commissioner of Finance and Administration in sending J. Alton Page to San Francisco, California, January 27-30, 1970, for the purpose described above is hereby ratified and approved. The Mayor and the Auditor are hereby authorized to draw a warrant for \$261.30 in favor of J. Alton Page for expenses incurred on the trip to San Francisco. Said warrant shall be charged to Model Cities fund Model Cities Administration, Travel and Transportation (6683.310). J. Alton Page shall file with the Auditor an accounting of actual expenses together with available receipts and any remaining balance shall be deposited with the Treasurer and credited to the above appropriation.

Section 2. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Portland in this: In order that there may be no unnecessary delay in ratifying the action of the Commissioner of Finance and Administration in sending J. Alton Page to San Francisco, California, January 27-30, 1970; therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.


