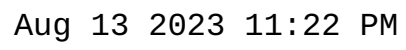

Below you will see my letter to the City Council on April 26, 2021, on behalf of the St Johns Neighborhood Association. We are soon approaching one year from when the St. Johns Neighborhood Association, which encompasses about 15,000 people, voted in favor of the Frog Ferry pilot program to launch in May 2022 (along with Cathedral Park Neighborhood Association and University Park Neighborhood Association). This pilot program was a beacon of hope for alternative means of transportation for our North Portland Community. It gave us hope that we would be less reliant on the St Johns Bridge, Columbia Drive, Willamette Drive, and continuous-and-upcoming closure of the I-5 bridge. Also, this would provide a way for the 500 OHSU residents in St Johns to commute to their work. We recently learned that the City Council did not push for any funding besides "fortifying the docks," according to Commissioner Hardesty.

Moreover, we learned that Tri-Met denied the committed funding to Frog Ferry due to bureaucratic anomalies towards their reimbursement filing that negates them from continuing with their excellent work. As City and State Representatives, we hope that you can support our efforts in diversifying our means of transportation, allow for federal ferry funding to come to Oregon, and promote the benefits of utilizing our outdoors for a better life for today and tomorrow. I will not be able to attend your meeting due to a schedule conflict, but I would like for you all to once again hear our community's thoughts from last year that are still relevant today.

April 26, 2021

Our St. Johns Neighborhood Association wants to see visionary and alternative modes of transit to



improve our collective quality of life and economy. We need to approach our transportation issues with systemic improvements that better connect communities to communities and challenge the status quo of road expansions. The rapid population growth our region is experiencing calls for courageous and innovative ways to move people and free up our highways for better freight mobility. Our residents in St. Johns often sit in dense traffic during commuter hours, on roadways that hug the Willamette River, which provides the capacity for passenger ferry transit.

River cities worldwide have found that ferries are fast, reliable, and a relaxing commuting option. The river provides an uncongested transit corridor where people can move at a reasonable speed and safely get to work or home while enjoying Wi-Fi and a good cup of coffee. We need to connect districts and neighborhoods that are constrained by overwhelmed travel corridors such as I-5 and the St. Johns Bridge. Currently, 85% of our residents commute to work in single-occupancy vehicles.

Our community strongly supports the goals of equity, diversity-and-inclusion, and we have many low, and medium-income housing, a strong senior community, and 47 percent of our population identifies as non-white.

A passenger ferry stop at the Cathedral Park dock will improve our St. John's Neighborhood residents' quality of life and provide a new transit mode to get commuters out of their cars and onto a refreshingly clean, green, safe, reliable, and relaxing mode of public transit.

We endorse pursuing the concept of initiating a pilot project proof of concept from the Cathedral Park dock to OHSU and ask that you keep us apprised of your progress.

"Focus is to start a pilot project proof of concept—with one vessel serving the Cathedral Park dock to the RiverPlace dock (enhancing existing infrastructure) to run from summer 2022-2024. We are in communications with Portland Parks and the Oregon State Marine Board, -- which have jurisdiction over the land access and the dock itself. Below is an overview of the Frog Ferry concept as well as a Business Plan for the pilot project. Please note we have a short-term plan for the pilot project using the existing dock and long-term, we would like to build out a dock for the ferry in 2024 or put the dock at Green Anchors (we are in communications with their team).

Read the PSC's recommendations to City Council

You can review the Planning and Sustainability Commission's recommendation to City Council in their Residential Infill Project Recommended Draft. The key zoning changes in the PSC's recommendation include:

- Increase the range of permissible housing types (e.g., duplexes, triplexes, fourplexes and additional accessory dwelling units).
- Expand the area where these housing types would be allowed (replaces the previously proposed 'a' overlay with the 'z' overlay, which limits where these housing types can be built based on landslide risk, flood plain and natural resources).
- Scale the building size limits to increase incrementally with the second or third unit. For instance, on a 5,000 sf R5 zoned lot, a house could be up to 2,500 sf, a duplex 3,000 sf, and a triplex or fourplex tops out at 3,500 sf.
- Remove minimum parking requirements and add new garage design requirements.

Notes from the North Portland Parks  
Advisory Group meeting on Sept 6th.,  
2017

We started with announcements:

- \* There is a workshop offered by the Portland Parks Foundation on Sept 11th, 9-11:30 at Matt Dishman. Ctr deadline to sign up is today, Sept 8th. This is new and different from the last workshop. If interested and you miss the deadline or to sign up - contact [khurst@PortlandPF.org](mailto:khurst@PortlandPF.org)

- \* North Portland Neightnorhood Small Grants just opened, meeting dates are set, check with Mary Jaron Kelly at [mary@npnscommunity.org](mailto:mary@npnscommunity.org). Deadline is November 13th, 2pm, so lots of time

- \* Help finish the work and paint on Paul Bunyan in Kenton - Saturday, Sept 9th, 12-7pm, music, food carts, and a special Widmer Tall Paul Lager on sale.

- \* also on Saturday, Sept 9th, at 10 am, an AARP walk in Peninsula Park, including the Rose Garden and historic homes close by, meet at the southern entrance to the Rose Garden off Ainsworth.

Cynthia and I also shared with the group about a meeting we had with Soo Pak and Chariti Montez of PP&R. They have made staffing changes. Chariti is not full time year round rather than a seasonal employee for Summer Free for All. @ staff positions have also been added to Summer Free for All to aid in planning, facilitating programs, and communication. It seems like they are trying. They said each movie or concert in a Park costs them \$4,000. I suggested that NA's might want to have these events, but the \$750 bill is too much for most. I suggested a neighborhood group contribution to these costs would be more likely to be between \$500-\$600. Most have only a budget of \$1,100 overall each year. They highlighted the Summer Lunch Program - it is impressive. We have asked for more

info on that to share. In East County they go to apartment buildings as there are not enough Parks. In North Portland they go where the PPS data shows a concentration of children on free and reduced lunch during the past school year. This is a once a week lunch with activities mainly provided by volunteers. 2 paid staff work on food distribution. safety and data collection.

Planning for October 4th meeting with PP&R staff:

We identified these topics and these people to bring up each of these topics. I will forward the topics only to PP&R staff via Jessie Bond later today.

\*\* we want to "drive the meeting ourselves" so that is why we asked for volunteers to bring up each topic. I will let Jessie know we have folks who will bring up each topic. Oriana and a PP&R staff person will need to moderate to keep the discussion going and make sure each topic gets time.

Topics and folks to open each discussion:

- \* Communication overall - Judy. This can include having a PP&R person at all meetings, follow up to letters and e-mail sent, notice of changes or opportunities to give input, meetings/hearings on issues.

- \* Community Engagement - Jeff. Strong ties to communication - valuing us as partners in all things Parks & Recreation, valuing neighborhood groups and input from all, starting out way ahead to allow for inquiry from our neighbors and meaningful feedback to PP&R staff

- \* Master Plans - Angela - those expiring, renewal, new plans - part of both above - how can we be part and reach out to include input from NA's and neighbors

- \* Funding - Oriana - how are decisions made? how can we and NA's and other groups have input beyond public hearings

We would also like to explore:

- \* PIR mitigation funds - Cynthia - how much is there? is it available?

how is it accessed? how are decisions made on this fund?

New Facilitator: Oriana Magnera

Oriana introduced herself to the group - for those not there, she is a Colorado native, values open spaces, works in energy policy and renewal energy. Lived in University Park and now in Portsmouth - got engaged with us via the UP NA. She wants feedback on the direction of the group.

The rest of the group in attendance introduced ourselves to her. She will be planning the Agendas, facilitating meetings, etc. from now on.
