ORDINANCE NO. 150294

An Ordinance changing the name of that portion of N.W. Irving Avenue lying between the northeasterly line of N.W. Barnes Road and its terminus near the north line of Seblar, a recorded plat in Multnomah County, Oregon, to N.W. Pittock Avenue, repealing Ordinance No. 149569, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

#### Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. A petition to change the name of that portion of N.W. Irving Avenue lying between the northeasterly line of N.W. Barnes Road and the north line of the recorded plat of Seblar, to N.W. Pittock Avenue was filed with the City Engineer, said petition containing the signatures of all property owners residing on said street.
- 2. The reason given for requesting the name change is to eliminate difficulties and confusion in mail delivery and in the assignment of precincts by the Election Board.
- 3. The Bureau of Parks and the Pittock Mansion Advisory Board were notified of the proposed name change and reported no objections thereto.
- 4. The request is reasonable and appropriate, and the change is recommended by the City Engineer and the Commissioner of Public Works.
- 5. That Ordinance No. 149569 passed by the Council May 7, 1980 was intended to change the street name as requested; however, it was later found the description of the portion of the street intended to be changed as contained in that ordinance was faulty, and the result was that more confusion was created than was eliminated, and that said ordinance should now be repealed.

#### NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The name of that portion of N.W. Irving Avenue lying between the northeasterly line of N.W. Barnes Road and the north line of Seblar, a recorded plat, is changed to N.W. Pittock Avenue.
- b. Ordinance No. 149569 entitled "An Ordinance changing the name of the street lying between the northeasterly line of N.W. Barnes Road and the southeasterly line of N.W. Seblar Drive from N.W. Irving Avenue to N.W. Pittock Avenue, and declaring an emergency", is hereby repealed.

#### ORDINANCE No.

Section 2. The Council declares an emergency exists because there should be no delay in changing the name of a street in order to eliminate present confusion; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.

Dear Portlander:

A recent inspection of the southeast corner of the intersection of S.W. Iowa Street and Hood Avenueshaweddviaibility at the intersection was obstructed by an overgrown shrub.

In order to provide adequate sight distance for safe vehicular passage through the intersection, it is necessary to maintain an area on each corner that is free of visibility obstructions.

It is the recommendation of this Bureau that the shrub be trimmed to a height of two feet, or be removed altogether. The City Vehicles and Traffic Code (Chapter 16.26.240, copy enclosed) describes the required portion of corner properties that must be kept clear of visibility obstructions.

An inspection will be made in ten (10) days and if this obstruction has not been removed, the matter will be turned over to the Bureau of Neighborhood Environment.

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
