

Recently, the Portland Post Office had a serious motor vehicle accident at the intersection of N.W. 10th Avenue and N.W. Hoyt Street. The primary cause of this accident was the poor visibility of traffic available to our driver.

The business located on this corner has a two stall truck loading zone located on the S. W. corner of N.W. 10th and N.W. Hoyt Street. When two large trucks are parked in this location it is virtually impossible to see the northbound traffic on 10th Street (please refer attached diagram).

Because of the one serious accident we have had and the many near misses, we would like to have this truck parking area removed, if at all possible. Other delivery service type of agencies have also expressed a deep concern for the dangerous character of this intersection.

This permit is automatically revoked without further action by the Council if this insurance is permitted to lapse, is cancelled or, for any other reason, becomes inoperative.				
	4. This permit is revocable at any time, either by the Bureau of Police or the City Engineer, and no expenditure of money or lapse of time or other act or thing shall operate as an estoppel against the City of Portland or be held to give the grantee any vested or other right. Upon revocation of this permit, the grantee shall immediately reopen said street to the normal use of the public.
