



Downtown Portland Clean and Safe, a non-profit that services the oldest of Portland's Enhanced Services Districts (ESDs), has petitioned the City asking for revised boundaries, a rate structure overhaul that will include residential rate caps, and a new 10-year district reauthorization. If approved by City Council, these changes will go into effect **August 1, 2025**.


