Enclosed please find the Postal Service's claim for property damage sustained to the Postal Service vehicle which was involved in an automobile collision with your insured Ken Le that occurred on 06-10-2025, at or near in or around West linn, OR. Our investigation reveals that your insured is responsible for this accident in that Portland Police vehicle struck our USPS delivery vehicle as it was stationary while delivering mail to a curbside mailbox.

As a result of the accident, the Postal Service vehicle sustained **\$92.01** in damage and is demanding the full amount from your company. To support our claim, a copy of the Vehicle Cost spreadsheet and/or work repairs, repair estimates, photographs, etc. are enclosed. Please be advised that pursuant to 28 U.S.C. 2415(b), the statute of limitation on affirmative actions brought by the United States is three years. Specifically, "Subject to the provisions of section 2416 of this title, and except as otherwise provided by Congress, every action for money damages brought by the United States or an officer or agency thereof which is founded upon a tort shall be barred unless the complaint is filed within **three years** after the right of action first accrues."
