

ORDINANCE No. 176145

*Contract with CMTS, Inc. to supply qualified construction management, inspection, and project support personnel upon request. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Bureau of Environmental Services has a need for temporary construction management, inspection, and project support personnel during peak construction periods for projects included in the bureau's annual Capital Improvement Program.
2. A consultant selection process has been conducted in accordance with Chapter 5.68 of the Portland City Code.
3. Funds are available in the FY 2001-2002 Sewer Operating Adopted Budget and will be included in the FY 2002-2003 budget request.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Commissioner of Public Affairs and Auditor are authorized to enter into a contract with CMTS, Inc. to provide qualified construction management, inspection and project support personnel to the Bureau of Environmental Services at a cost not to exceed \$2,000,000 substantially similar to that attached hereto as Exhibit A.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants payable to CMTS, Inc. chargeable to the Sewer System Operating Fund when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.
- c. The Project Manager is hereby authorized to execute amendments not increasing the cost above the original amount or extending the contract time. Any amendments that increase the amount of compensation payable to the contractor must be approved by ordinance of the City Council.
