

ORDINANCE No. 176147

*Contract with HDR Engineering, Inc. for professional engineering services for the Columbia Boulevard Wastewater Treatment Plant Sodium Hypochlorite Conversion, Project No. 6700. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Bureau of Environmental Services (BES) has need of a consulting engineering firm to prepare preliminary design, final design, and services during bid elements for the Columbia Boulevard Wastewater Treatment Plant (CBWTP) Sodium Hypochlorite Conversion, Project No. 6700.
2. The consultant selection has been conducted in accordance with Chapter 5.68 of the Code of the City of Portland. The consultant selection committee recommends that HDR Engineering, Inc. be retained to perform the preliminary design, final design and design during bidding services.
3. The scope of work for this contract includes preliminary design, final design and services during bidding. The fee under this ordinance is for the preliminary design work. After the final design scope of work and direction of the design effort is determined, BES will prepare a design and bid services amendment for Council approval.
4. The established cost is \$119,519. Funds are available in the adopted Sewer System Operating Fund, FY 2001-2002 Budget, Bureau of Environmental Services, Center Code 145-22-110, Project Number 6700, Account No. 521000

NOW, THEREFORE, the council directs:

- a. The Commissioner of Public Affairs and Auditor are authorized to execute a contract with HDR Engineering, Inc. for the purpose described in Section 1, in the amount of \$119,519.
- b. The Director of the Bureau of Environmental Services shall be authorized to approve changes to the contract price up to 10 percent of the contract amount.
- c. The City's Project Manager may execute any amendments not increasing the cost ceiling.
- d. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because the services of the consulting engineers are needed to begin this project in a timely manner and avoid delays to the subsequent and related contracts. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
