ORDINANCE NO. 176155

* Amend contract with Warner Pacific College to increase compensation to the College for additional space and services. (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 33027)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Portland Police Bureau's Oregon Police Corps Division trains recently graduated college students to prepare them for a career in law enforcement.
- 2. The costs of the program are covered by federal grant.
- 3. The program was more successful in recruiting cadets than expected. The result is a need for additional space and services.
- 4. To acquire the added space and services the program needs to pay Warner Pacific College an additional \$125,000. This will increase total compensation to \$275,000.

NOW, therefore, the Council directs:

a. The Mayor and the Auditor are hereby authorized to amend contract 33027 between the City of Portland and Warner Pacific College attached as Exhibits A and B.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because delay in proceeding with this agreement will unnecessarily deprive the City of Portland and Warner Pacific College of the mutual benefits of this agreement; therefore this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
