*Accept assignment of assets from Classical Chinese Garden Trust, an Oregon non-profit corporation. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Classical Chinese Garden Trust ("Trust") was incorporated as an Oregon non-profit corporation, and qualified to receive charitable contributions under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.
- 2. The purpose for which the Trust was incorporated was to raise funds for and to administer the construction of Lan Su Yuan, the Portland Classical Chinese Garden.
- 3. Substantially all of the money pledged to the Project has been collected, and the construction is complete, and the Trust, having completed its mission, wishes to dissolve.
- 4. The Trust has assets, in the form of cash on hand in the City of Portland's Classical Chinese Garden Trust Account, a few remaining uncollected pledges, an insurance claim for damage to components of the Project suffered while en route from China, and claims, warranties or other rights existing under the design and construction contracts for the project.
- 5. Consistent with its articles of incorporation, the Trust wishes to assign these assets to the City for the benefit of the Lan Su Yuan Portland Classical Chinese Garden, and it is in the public interest to accept the assignment.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. The Mayor is authorized to execute and accept on behalf of the City of Portland an Assignment agreement with Classical Chinese Garden Trust, an Oregon non-profit corporation, generally in the form attached to this Ordinance, once that Assignment is approved as to form by the City Attorney.

The Council declares that an emergency exists in order to provide for the winding Section 2. up of the affairs of the Trust, and for the protection of the assets, rights and interests to be assigned; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
