ORDINANCE NO.

\* Permit an exception to City Code 4.24.010 (prohibiting other employment while on an unpaid leave of absence) for Criminalist John F. Courtney to take unpaid leave as a temporary federal employee in the National Disaster Medical System Disaster Mortuary Response Team and receive compensation from the federal government (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The proposed exception is consistent with the intent of City Council to support Civil Defense activities, as expressed in City Code 4.24.150, which provides for employees to be absent from their duties to attend civil defense meetings.
2. In a disaster, the public will benefit from Criminalist Courtney's participation in the federal National Disaster Medical System (NDMS), Disaster Mortuary Response Team (DMORT) through the provision of temporary, secure morgue facilities; victim identification; processing, preparation, and disposition of remains.
3. For his work as a temporary federal employee with NDMS/DMORT during times of disaster, Criminalist Courtney should be compensated by the federal government.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. An exception to City Code 4.24.010 is permitted on an as needed basis for Criminalist John F. Courtney to take unpaid leave and receive compensation for his participation as a temporary federal employee in the National Disaster Medical System (NDMS), Disaster Mortuary Response Team (DMORT).

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because of the need to act in a timely manner given that a disaster could occur at any time. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
