AMENDMENT NO. TWO

CONTRACT NO. 31566

FOR FURNISHING

TELECOMMUNICATIONS CONSULTING SERVICES

This amendment is between **W & H Pacific** (Contractor) and the **City of Portland** (City), and modifies Contract No. 31566 dated January 27, 1998, as amended on April 21, 1998.

1. The City and W & H Pacific hereby modify Contract No. 31566, as previously modified, to extend the termination date from December 31, 1999 to December 31, 2000.
2. The contract is hereby amended to authorize expenditure of a not-to-exceed amount of \$190,000 for this one-year period for Phase III.
3. Except as modified above, and as previously modified, all other terms and conditions shall remain the same.

ORDINANCE No.

* Amend Contract with W & H Pacific to provide Telecommunications Engineering and Consulting Services for the Bureau of General Services, Communications Division, to extend termination date. (Ordinance; Amend Contract No. 31566)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Bureau of General Services requires the services of W & H Pacific to implement Phase III of the Wide Area Engineering Project and other special network infrastructure projects over time. The original contract provided that W & H Pacific would provide specialized telecommunications network design and engineering services on a project by project basis under Phase III of the Agreement.
2. This contract was awarded through a competitive process, in accordance with PCC 5.68.
3. Phase III of the project is anticipated to continue for a period of three (3) years and will include engineering, design and consulting services for telecommunications and radio system infrastructure and services. Phase III of the project includes various small projects to extend or improve telecommunications networks required by City Bureaus
4. This Ordinance authorizes an amendment to the contract to extend the expiration date of the contract from December 31, 1999 to December 31, 2000, and authorizes the expenditure of a not-to-exceed amount of \$190,000 for this one-year period for Phase III.
5. Funds for this project will be paid from BGS Communications Services Telecommunications Fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Commissioner and Auditor are hereby authorized to execute an amendment to Contract No. 31566 with W & H Pacific substantially in conformance with the draft contract attached as Exhibit A to be approved by the City Attorney.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the FY 1999-0 through 2000-1 budgets of the Bureau of General Services, when demand is presented and approved by the proper authorities.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay in proceeding with the project will unnecessarily deprive the City of the benefits of completion of the contract and will potentially result in elevated communications project costs to City Bureaus; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
