*Accept funds from the State Farm Insurance Company in the amount of \$100,000 to conduct traffic engineering analyses at five intersection locations: NE Halsey and 102nd; SE Division and 82nd; SE Foster and 82nd; SE Powell and 39th; and SE Powell and 82nd. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. State Farm Insurance Company has offered \$100,000 to the City of Portland for the study of five intersections with high crash histories.
2. The City of Portland's Bureau of Transportation System Management has a consulting team available through an annual flexible services agreement to conduct the required engineering analyses. City staff will manage the studies, and report findings to the insurance company.
3. This project is beneficial to the City in that external resources are being made available to conduct needed traffic safety engineering analysis.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept the State Farm Insurance appropriation of \$100,000 on behalf of the Bureau of Transportation System Management.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because any delay will cause unnecessary delay in the project implementation; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
