 Approve a location in Washington Park as the site for a Holocaust Memorial Garden  
(Resolution)

**WHEREAS**, the Oregon Holocaust Survivors, Refugees, and Families approached the City seeking its dedication of a site for a contemplative memorial garden

**WHEREAS**, the memorial garden will be a plea for all people to remember each person's right to exist without fear

**WHEREAS**, the Oregon Holocaust Survivors, Refugees, and Families has worked closely with Portland Parks and Recreation to identify a site for a contemplative garden

**WHEREAS**, the site identified is within Washington Park near SW Sacajawea Boulevard and SW Washington Way

**WHEREAS**, the Oregon Holocaust Survivors, Refugees, and Families enlisted landscape architectural assistance to develop a garden design, and are, furthermore, prepared to raise funds for construction and maintenance of the garden

**WHEREAS**, City Council wishes to support the Oregon Holocaust Survivors, Refugees, and Families in siting and developing a memorial garden in memory of millions of people who were sacrificed because of hate and intolerance, and to be a continuing reminder of the need to steadfastly oppose such hatred and intolerance


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Portland, a municipal corporation in the State of Oregon, that the City designates an area within Washington Park in the lawn north of SW Sacajawea Boulevard and encompassed by SW Washington Way

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Oregon Holocaust Survivors, Refugees and Families will design and seek necessary approvals for construction of the Memorial

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that Portland Parks and Recreation will work with the Oregon Holocaust Survivors, Refugees and Families to develop a revocable permit for the construction and dedication to the City of Portland of a Holocaust Memorial
