## RESOLUTION No. 35443

Declare moratorium on issuance of phone booth permits (Resolution)

- WHEREAS, the placement of public pay telephones on City of Portland ("City") City streets has historically been authorized by the City as a public convenience:
- WHEREAS, while the City has issued permits for public pay telephones on a non-exclusive basis. the City has until this time only permitted one provider (Pacific Northwest Bell, now US WEST Communications) to place public pay telephones in City rights of way:
- WHEREAS, the public pay telephone business has become highly competitive, and multiple providers now compete for the placement of booths within the City:
- WHEREAS, competition by multiple providers for placement of telephone booths in the right of way can create sidewalk congestion, street management difficulties, and conflicts with adjacent property owners:
- WHEREAS, the City needs to determine if the public interest will be served by authorizing more than one provider of public pay telephone booths in City right of way; and to that end will be authorizing one additional provider (Roof Tops) on an experimental basis:
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council imposes a moratorium of three vears on authorizing any additional providers of public pay telephone booth in City rights of way beyond the two providers (US West and Roof Tops) which the Council has separately authorized;
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council will not authorize any additional providers of public pay telephone booths in the right of way until the trial period created by the moratorium is concluded and the results of the trial evaluated.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Office of Cable Communications and Franchise Management and the Bureau of Transportation Engineering shall report to the Council by June 1, 1998 on:

- (a) whether the public interest is served by authorizing more than one provider of public pay telephone booths in City right of way;
- whether competition among multiple providers can be managed in such a way as (b) to enhance City revenues while reducing sidewalk congestion, street management difficulties, and conflicts with property owners; and
- the Office's and Bureau's recommendation as to whether the moratorium (c) imposed by this resolution should be extended, amended, or allowed to expire.
