WHEREAS, a Charitable Campaign Committee, composed of a representative appointed by the Mayor and each Commissioner, has been created pursuant to Chapter 5 10 of the City Code

WHEREAS, the Charitable Campaign Committee has established rules and guidelines in accordance with Chapter 5 10 of the City Code for participation in the 1995 Campaign

WHEREAS, an application was developed by the Charitable Campaign Committee and forwarded to agencies expressing interest in participating in the Campaign

WHEREAS, eight applications or written statements of intent to continue participation and two new applications have been received and reviewed by the Charitable Campaign Committee
